

Rules - 2011 Trump National Golf Club



GENERAL INFORMATION FOR GOLFERS:

- Registration will start in the main entrance to Trump National Golf Club at 9:00am on October 10, 2011. **Please register immediately upon arrival at the club.**
- The driving range and the putting green will be available starting at 9:00am.
- We have a full agenda and a fun day planned for you, so we have set a goal of concluding play in 4 hours and 30 minutes.
- There are 2 different formats for the event. There is a Captains Choice (Scramble) on the River Course and a 2-Best Ball on the Championship Course. There will be gross and net prizes for both formats.
- The Tee Off Time is set for 11:30am. Please be at your carts and ready to go.
- We will collect a USGA Index from all golfers. We will need to know your September 1, 2011 USGA Index and the name of the course where the USGA Index is maintained. Those golfers without an established USGA Index will be assigned a Day Handicap by the LeaderBoard Scoring System.
- Men will play from the blue tees, women from the red tees and seniors 70 years and above will play from the green tees.
- There will be Straight Drive, Closest-to-the-Pin and Hole-in-One contests on each course. Mulligans may NOT be used for these competitions.
- Only the first Hole-in-One on each competition hole will be eligible for prizes.
- A ball lost or a ball out of play should be played as a lateral hazard, with a one stroke penalty
- Take no more than 3 minutes to look for a lost ball.
- Please indicate your preference of event format (Captains Choice or 2-Best Ball) at the time that you register for the event. We will fill these event spots on a first come, first served basis.
- LeaderBoard Scoring Systems will be doing the scoring for this event. Representatives from LeaderBoard will explain how to use their scoring cards before play begins, and will gather your completed cards at the conclusion of play. Please turn your scorecards in immediately after play.
- Please take time to repair your ball marks and divots.

CAPTAIN'S CHOICE (SCRAMBLE) RULES:

- Teams will consist of 4 players. If you only have three players, then you will rotate the fourth shot.
- All players will tee off on each hole.
- Then the team selects the ball they feel is in the best position.
- From that point each player plays a second shot from the same location.
- This process continues until the ball is holed. There are no "gimmies" everything, must be putted out. Unless the team has reached triple bogey. Then you pick up and move to the next hole.
- 2 tee shots must be used during the event from each player.
- The ball may be moved within one club length of the chosen spot, but not closer to the hole, and this must not result in a change in surface (i.e. from the rough to the fairway, or from the fringe to the green)
- To speed up play, a team should not take more than a triple bogey on any hole.

TWO-BEST BALL RULES:

- Each player in the foursome plays his or her own ball throughout the event.
- USGA Summer rules apply, so please play the ball as it lies.
- Each player's ball must be holed. There are no "gimmies". And **ALL 4 SCORES MUST BE RECORDED ON THE SCORECARD.**
- Only the two lowest scores (gross and net) for the foursome will be combined to make up the team score for that hole. LeaderBoard Scoring Systems Representatives will explain the use of the scorecard prior to the beginning of play.
- To speed up play, an individual player should not take more than a triple bogey on any hole.

Again, as a reminder, please turn in your signed and dated scorecards to the LeaderBoard Scoring System representatives immediately upon the conclusion of play. Volunteers will be on hand to offer assistance should you require it. The cocktail reception is scheduled to begin at 5pm on the outdoor patio.
